



FACT SHEET FOR STUDENTS ATTENDING THE RYLA CONFERENCE

Congratulations! You have been selected and sponsored by the Rotary Club in your area to attend the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards Conference.

The Rotary Youth Leadership Award (RYLA) is a program for high school sophomores who have shown leadership potential in their home, school and community. The conference is designed to introduce participants to thoughts and ideas which if utilized will strengthen and develop their leadership skills. It also provides an environment where participants may discuss and exchange ideas with other students from North-East Pennsylvania. The conference lasts five days and is held on the campus of Keystone College in Factoryville, PA.

Arrival at Keystone and registration is SUNDAY, JULY 10 from 2:30-3:15 PM

RYLA graduation is THURSDAY, JULY 14, at 3:30-5:00 PM. Family is invited.

Departure is immediately following graduation at approximately 5:30 PM.

Directions to Keystone College:

From the North:

Interstate 81 South to Exit 202, Tompkinsville; West 8 miles on Route 107; Left on Routes 6 & 11 to Keystone.

From the South:

Via Interstate 81; North to Exit 194, Clarks Summit; North 8 miles on Routes 6 & 11 to Keystone. Via Pennsylvania Turnpike: Turnpike (Northeast Extension - Interstate 476); North to Exit 131 Clarks Summit; North 8 miles on Routes 6 & 11 to Keystone.

From the West:

Interstate 80 East to Interstate 81 North; 81 North to exit 194, Clarks Summit; North 8 miles on Routes 6 & 11 to Keystone.

From the East:

Interstate 84 East to Interstate 380 North to Interstate 81 North; North to Exit 194, Clarks Summit; North 8 miles on Routes 6 & 11 to Keystone.
